

# Bring Your Expired or Unused Medications to Clinic Ole



Expired medications can have harmful effects. They can be unpredictable, ineffective or even toxic.

## Examples of Medications:

- Prescription medications
- Over-the-counter medications
- Inhalers
- Syrups
- Homeopathic medicines
- Supplements
- Sprays
- Ointments/Creams



## Disposal Instructions:

- Remove medications from bottle or container (except liquids).
- Place medications into a zip lock or sealable bag.
- Remove or cross out personal information from medication bottle or container.
- Place zip lock bag with medication into secure medicine drop box at one of the three Clinic Ole locations.
- Place medication bottles or containers into recycling.



Don't flush your medicines down the toilet or throw them in the trash because they can harm the environment and our water supply.

Do your part in protecting your family and the environment.

We do not accept controlled substances.
